JOB DESCRIPTION

This position is responsible to assist with the proper installation, maintenance, and operating condition of the Laie Community Water and Wastewater Systems, and assists in the operation and maintenance of a public drinking water system including, but not limited to: line repair, new service installation, meter reading, meter replacement, hydrant testing, pump station monitoring, disinfection system operating and monitoring. With the oversight of an immediate supervisor, uses judgment to ensure that utility lines are properly maintained, operated and repaired in accordance with Utility, Federal, State and County Regulatory Agency requirements.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

Candidate must be a high school graduate, have a valid Hawaii State driver's license, and have plumbing or construction related experience. Must be able to skillfully operate maintenance, plumbing and light construction equipment on a regular basis. Requires a considerable amount of frequent walking, standing, kneeling, crouching/bending, crawling, lifting, and dexterity; working with, around and over tanks of water and chemicals; visual acuity (day and night); to complete essential job duties. Requires lifting and carrying equipment and work items up to 100 pounds unassisted. Must be able to reach the Laie Community within 30 minutes when on (after-hours) call. Must be able to use basic algebra to determine proper liquid ratios.
