This position maintains HRI managed facilities and assigned company properties, including landscaping, community common areas, cemetery, parks, beach areas, streets, street lights, roads, drainage, streams, ditches, pump stations, reservoirs, control equipment, etc. and other vital functions as assigned by the Maintenance Supervisor. This is an entry-level position.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

Must be able to perform tasks that may be considered tedious, such as raking, shoveling, pruning, hauling plants, lifting heavy bags of trash, and working outdoors while exposed to the sun, wind, rain, and safe levels of chemicals such as pesticides. Must be able to safely and skillfully operate power equipment and heavy equipment to perform the essential job duties. Must be able to do strenuous physical work and lifting and carrying equipment and work items up to 100 pounds unassisted. Requires frequent walking, standing, kneeling, lifting, and bending. Must be able to work overtime, weekends and holidays as needed. Must have a valid Hawaii State driver's license.
