Theme: “What I love about Laie”

Prizes: 1st \$500, 2nd \$250, 3rd \$150. All other photos chosen for use in the calendar will receive a cash prize of \$50. About 12 photos will be selected for use in the calendar.

Contest Rules:

Photos must have been taken in the last 15 years (since 1993 – when HRI was formed), and must be received by Wednesday, October 15, 2008. One entry per person.

Photos will be chosen from an anonymous pool by an independent selection committee composed of a respected professional photographer, a writer and

a kupuna from the community.

Please submit digitized photos or photo prints at the HRI office. No photocopied reproduction prints, please. Digitized photos are preferred for quality purposes, and must be 8.25 inches high by 11.25 inches wide or larger, and be 250 dpi in resolution or higher.

While JPEGs are acceptable, TIFFs or PNGs are recommended. Photos can be submitted on digital media (CD, DVD, etc.) or in print format at the HRI office in the Laie Shopping Center. Photos can also be e-mailed to us at contact_us@hawaiireserves.com. Photos and digital media left at HRI will be available for pick-up during normal business hours from November 15 through December 31, 2008.

All winners will be required to sign a consent and use form prior to receiving a cash prize and having their photo featured in the calendar. Contestants must be over 18, or have their parents / legal guardians sign for them.

Photos must be accompanied by the photographer's name, age (if a minor), a title, and a one sentence narrative (15 words or less) about how the photo illustrates *what you love about Laie*.
